


NOTICE OF HEARING

In view of the Governor's Executive Order of March 12, 2020 regarding the novel coronavirus: NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Directors of the Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency will continue its public hearing on proposed water standby charges for fiscal year 2020-2021 from April 2, 2020 to the regularly scheduled Board meeting of Thursday, May 7, 2020, at the hour of 2:00 P.M., at the Agency's Board room located at 24116 Crest Forest Drive in Crestline, California. Standby charges are proposed to be levied in the same amounts as established for fiscal year 2019-2020. Protests, if any, must be in writing signed by the landowner, must be filed with the Agency prior conclusion of the hearing, and must contain a description sufficient to identify the land owned by the landowner. An engineer's report has been prepared and is on file with the Agency which identifies the proposed charge for each affected parcel within the Agency, as well as the rationale and method of calculation. The report is available for public review at the Agency's office.
